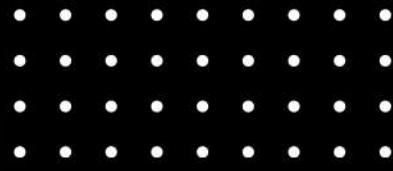
FOOTBALL ACADEMY OPPORTUNITIES (BOTH COURSES)

FEES, KIT & ENRICHMENT INFORMATION

- 1 Course Fees (NCFE / BTEC Qualification)**

There is no charge for the NCFE or BTEC qualification for students aged 16–18. Tuition, teaching, assessment and examination fees are fully government funded. There are no hidden academic costs.
- 2 FPF Academy Kit Package (Required)**

All players selected into the FPF Academy programme are required to wear official academy kit. This ensures a professional training environment, equality across squads, and clear team identity. **Annual cost:** £250 (one-off annual package) **Includes:** Training kit, match kit, tracksuit/outerwear and performance wear.
- 3 Matchday Travel & Transport**

Travel arrangements vary depending on fixture location and may include parent-arranged travel, shared minibus transport or a seasonal travel contribution where applicable. **Indicative cost:** £0–£150 per season depending on usage. Any travel contribution relates solely to football fixtures and is not linked to the qualification.
- 4 Optional Enrichment Opportunities**

FPF Academy offers optional enrichment activities designed to enhance player development and exposure, including showcase fixtures, professional club experiences, residential camps and UK or overseas tours. All enrichment opportunities are optional and charged separately if selected.
- 5 Financial Support**

Students eligible for college bursaries or learner support may be able to use this funding towards academy kit or travel costs, subject to college eligibility criteria.

Participation in the FPF Academy football programme is an enrichment opportunity alongside the student's college study programme. No charges are made for the delivery, assessment, or certification of the NCFE or BTEC qualification. Any costs relate solely to optional enrichment, kit, or football-specific activities.

By Bus

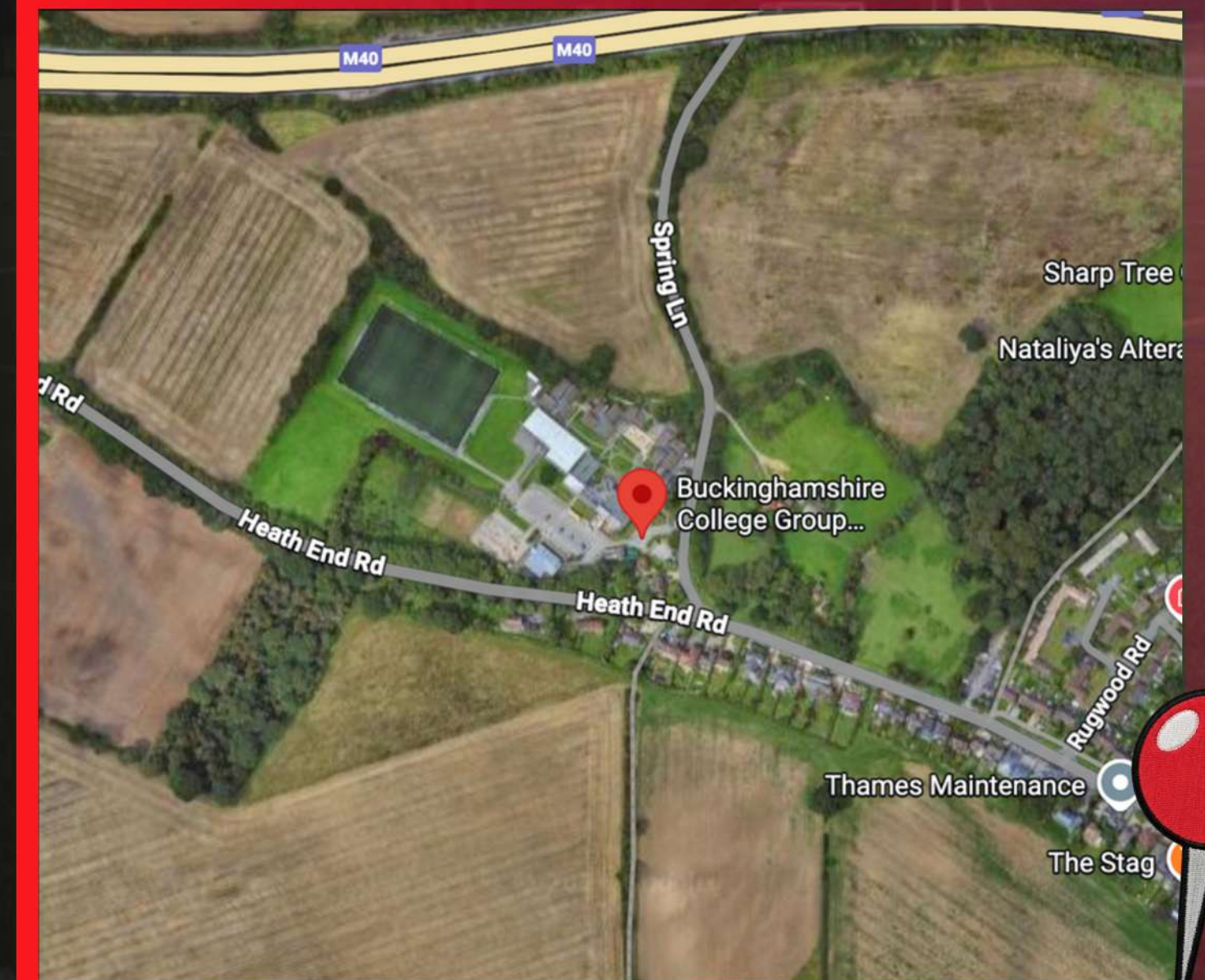
The Flackwell Heath Campus is well served by local bus routes connecting High Wycombe, Marlow, Bourne End and Beaconsfield. Bus stops are located within a short walking distance of the campus.

By Train

Nearest stations are Bourne End and High Wycombe, with regular services from London Marylebone. A short bus or taxi journey connects the stations to the campus.
